

Cherrytree Township Board of Supervisors
Special Meeting – Ordinance 02-2020 (Solar Regulations)
August 24, 2020

The Cherrytree Township Board of Supervisors held a special meeting on Monday, August 24, 2020, at 7:10 p.m., at the township building.
